## 1. ARRIVING TO SAN LORENZO DE EL ESCORIAL

Those students who come from abroad will probably arrive at Madrid-Barajas airport. The standard **taxi** price from the airport to the city centre is €30. Those students who arrive at Airport terminal number 4 (T4) may use the “**Exprés aeropuerto**” bus service. It leaves from T4 and arrives in Atocha and costs 5 €. The schedule for Sunday is:

**Metro** service may bring students both to Atocha and Chamartín stations:

Airport – Atocha

**Line 8** (Pink) – transfer in Nuevos Ministerios station to **Line 10** (Dark blue) – transfer in Tribunal station to **Line 1** (Light blue) – arrive at Atocha station.

Airport – Chamartín

**Line 8** (Pink) – transfer in Nuevos Ministerios station to **Line 10** (Dark blue) – arrive at Chamartín station.

From both Atocha and Chamartín stations, students may take a train to San Lorenzo de El Escorial (please, see [Resident students and Grant holders](#)).

### 1.a. Resident Students and Grant Holders

Resident students and grant holders are hosted at the course venue in San Lorenzo de El Escorial (from now on, SLDEE) during the course time.

The best time to arrive at SLDEE is Sunday 19th (the day before the course beginning) during the afternoon. To arrange the accommodation issues, they should attend the Secretary of Students sited in Euroforum Infantes (please, see [First day in SLDEE](#)) between 17.00 and 19.00 h. They may also arrive on 20th July in the morning with the free bus service (please, see [Guest students](#)) and arrange these issues before the first session of the course.

A taxi from Madrid to SLDEE is too expensive (almost €100 ) and there is not a tube service to SLDEE available. There is, instead, a public **interurban bus service from Moncloa station**. It provides an excellent service. The interurban bus number that students should take from Moncloa is **664**. Its **price is €4.20** and the trip takes **55 minutes** approximately. SLDEE is the last stop. A map to the Station can be found [here](#).

### 1.b. Guest students

Guest students are expected to manage their own accommodation. In case they decide to stay in Madrid during the course time, they can take advantage of the **daily free bus service** for Complutense Summer course attendees (Monday to Friday).

These buses leave from the corner of Calle Fernández de los Ríos and Calle Isaac Peral every day at 8.30 a.m. Here you can find a [map](#). This service goes back to Madrid at 19:50. If there is any extra activity in the evening the bus to Madrid will leave at 20:30. If you need to travel in different schedule you can use the interurban transportation between Madrid and El Escorial (bus or train), but that is not included and the participants should pay for it if they want to use it.



## 2. FIRST DAY IN SAN LORENZO DE EL ESCORIAL (SLDEE)

After arriving to SLDEE, students should go to [Euroforum Infantes](#), where the Secretary of Students is placed, to formalize their enrolment. There, all students will be informed about the course buildings, guest students will be provided with the bus card, resident students and grant holders will be informed about the accommodation emplacement, etc.
